

Bible Verses About God's Grace

For by **grace** you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast. **Ephesians 2:8-9**

But Noah found **grace** in the eyes of the Lord. **Genesis 6:8**

So the Lord said to Moses, "I will also do this thing that you have spoken; for you have found **grace** in My sight, and I know you by name." **Exodus 33:17**

You are fairer than the sons of men; **Grace** is poured upon Your lips; Therefore God has blessed You forever. **Psalms 45:2**

Surely He scorns the scornful, But gives **grace** to the humble.
Proverbs 3:34

And the Child grew and became strong in spirit, filled with wisdom; and the **grace** of God was upon Him **Luke 2:40**

And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of **grace** and truth. **John 1:14**

When he came and had seen the **grace** of God, he was glad, and encouraged them all that with purpose of heart they should continue with the Lord. **Acts 11:23**

For the Lord God is a sun and shield; The Lord will give **grace** and glory; No good thing will He withhold From those who walk uprightly.
Psalms 84:11

...through whom also we have access by faith into this **grace** in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God. **Romans 5:2**

For the law was given through Moses, but **grace** and truth came through Jesus Christ. **John 1:17**

And with great power the apostles gave witness to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. And great **grace** was upon them all. **Acts 4:33**

Having then gifts differing according to the **grace** that is given to us, let us use them: if prophecy, let us prophesy in proportion to our faith; **Romans 12:6**

Then he said, "If now I have found **grace** in Your sight, O Lord, let my Lord, I pray, go among us, even though we are a stiff-necked people; and pardon our iniquity and our sin, and take us as Your inheritance." **Exodus 34:9**

Nevertheless, brethren, I have written more boldly to you on some points, as reminding you, because of the **grace** given to me by God... **Romans 15:15**

"So now, brethren, I commend you to God and to the word of His **grace**, which is able to build you up and give you an inheritance among all those who are sanctified." **Acts 20:32**

For by **grace** you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God... **Ephesians 2:8**

But the free gift is not like the offense. For if by the one man's offense many died, much more the **grace** of God and the gift by the **grace** of the one Man, Jesus Christ, abounded to many. **Romans 5:15**

But we believe that through the **grace** of the Lord Jesus Christ we shall be saved in the same manner as they. **Acts 15:11**

For sin shall not have dominion over you, for you are not under law but under **grace**. **Romans 6:14**

...of which I became a minister according to the gift of the **grace** of God given to me by the effective working of His power. **Ephesians 3:7**

What then? Shall we sin because we are not under law but under **grace**? Certainly not! **Romans 6:15**

Now when the congregation had broken up, many of the Jews and devout proselytes followed Paul and Barnabas, who, speaking to them, persuaded them to continue in the **grace** of God. **Acts 13:43**

But as you abound in everything—in faith, in speech, in knowledge, in all diligence, and in your love for us—see that you abound in this **grace** also. **2 Corinthians 8:7**

...to the praise of the glory of His **grace**, by which He made us accepted in the Beloved. **Ephesians 1:6**

For I say, through the **grace** given to me, to everyone who is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think, but to think soberly, as God has dealt to each one a measure of faith.

Romans 12:3

But by the **grace** of God I am what I am, and His **grace** toward me was not in vain; but I labored more abundantly than they all, yet not I, but the **grace** of God which was with me. **1 Corinthians 15:10**

Moreover the law entered that the offense might abound. But where sin abounded, **grace** abounded much more... **Romans 5:20**

And He said to me, “My **grace** is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness.” Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.

2 Corinthians 12:9

Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. **Ephesians 1:2**

And God is able to make all **grace** abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may have an abundance for every good work. **2 Corinthians 9:8**

...that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His **grace** in His kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. **Ephesians 2:7**

Of this salvation the prophets have inquired and searched carefully, who prophesied of the **grace** that would come to you... **1 Peter 1:10**

Let no corrupt word proceed out of your mouth, but what is good for necessary edification, that it may impart **grace** to the hearers. **Ephesians 4:29**

Let your speech always be with **grace**, seasoned with salt, that you may know how you ought to answer each one. **Colossians 4:6**

Now may our Lord Jesus Christ Himself, and our God and Father, who has loved us and given us everlasting consolation and good hope by **grace**... **2 Thessalonians 2:16**

To me, who am less than the least of all the saints, this **grace** was given, that I should preach among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ... **Ephesians 3:8**

Therefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and rest your hope fully upon the **grace** that is to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ; **1 Peter 1:13**

Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom which cannot be shaken, let us have **grace**, by which we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear. **Hebrews 12:28**

And the **grace** of our Lord was exceedingly abundant, with faith and love which are in Christ Jesus. **1 Timothy 1:14**

But to each one of us **grace** was given according to the measure of Christ's gift. **Ephesians 4:7**

You therefore, my son, be strong in the **grace** that is in Christ Jesus. **2 Timothy 2:1**

For the **grace** of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men... **Titus 2:11**

Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of **grace**, that we may obtain mercy and find **grace** to help in time of need. **Hebrews 4:16**

But He gives more **grace**. Therefore He says: "God resists the proud, But gives **grace** to the humble." **James 4:6**

Who has saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and **grace** which was given to us in Christ Jesus before time began... **2 Timothy 1:9**

Likewise you younger people, submit yourselves to your elders. Yes, all of you be submissive to one another, and be clothed with humility, for "God resists the proud, But gives **grace** to the humble." **1 Peter 5:5**

Grace to you and peace from Him who is and who was and who is to come, and from the seven Spirits who are before His throne, **Revelation 1:4**

The **grace** of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all. Amen. **Revelation 22:21**
